

## About the Journal

*Acta Classica* is funded and produced by the Classical Association of South Africa, which is a registered Non-Profit Organization (060-093). It is accredited by the Thomson-Reuters Institute of Scientific Information (ISI) and the South African Department of Higher Education and Training (SAPSE). All of the journal's articles are indexed on Elsevier's SCOPUS list and on Thomson-Reuters' WEB OF SCIENCE (from 2009). From 2016 onwards articles published by the journal are included in the JSTOR portal (except for the 'moving wall' of the last three volumes), and on SABINET. Articles from Volume 57 (2014) carry the DOI tags required by international research bodies.

In 2018 *Acta Classica* entered its sixty-first year of production. The journal publishes full articles, miscellaneous articles, and reviews. The policies of the journal are explained on its website (see below).

The language of publication is mainly English, but many contributions have also been written in Afrikaans, German, French, Dutch, Latin, and Italian.

*Acta Classica* is an international journal. It has published work by scholars residing in South Africa, the United States of America,

the United Kingdom of Great Britain, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, The Netherlands / Belgium, Poland, Canada, Australia, Zambia, Zimbabwe, New Zealand, Israel, and Japan.

*Acta Classica* publishes work in all fields of Classics, from textual criticism to the Classical Tradition / Reception Studies. Many contributions have been made in the field of Ancient History, but the majority have been literary in nature. Further contributions have been made in the history of Classical Scholarship – including the work of South African Classics scholars, Greek and Latin Linguistics and Philology, Greek and Roman Philosophy, Lexicography, Religion, Epigraphy, Art, and Archaeology (including Mycenaeanology). There have also been articles in such diverse areas of study as Research Methodology in Classics and Byzantine / Medieval Studies.
