

Living Language Latin workshop!

During the week before the CASA conference a full immersion Latin workshop will take place at the Faculty of Theology of the North West University in Potchefstroom. The workshop will be presented by Nancy E Llewellyn, associate professor of Latin at Wyoming Catholic College. Nancy has previously studied with Reginald Foster at the Gregorian University, and has led numerous workshops on spoken Latin. The workshop offers high energy conversation exercises and readings from Latin literature in a supportive, intimidation-free environment. Participants will experience first-hand various teaching methods that are directly applicable to teaching Latin in the classroom. Please note that the number of participants are restricted and places will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis.

Program dates:

29 June – 6 July

ARRIVAL: Sunday, 28 June, 15:00 – 18:00

DEPARTURE (if you are not staying for the CASA conference): Saturday, July 4, 12:00 – 15:00

Location: The workshop will take place at the Faculty of Theology of the North West University, Room 204, Building K23, c/o Molen and Borcherd Street, Potchefstroom.

Eligibility: You are eligible to attend this workshop if you have already learned Latin on paper and are interested in developing active command of the spoken language. This is not an introductory Latin Course and it is not for people who have no knowledge of the language. Participants will have completed, at a minimum, the equivalent of two years of traditional university Latin or four years of a high school Latin program. It is not necessary to have previous experience speaking Latin.

Cost: The tuition fee is R750. This does not include accommodation, food or beverages (there are several good guesthouses and B+B's in the vicinity as well as reasonably priced restaurants and coffee shops).
