Greetings to all participants,

We are happy to announce that we can distribute a registration form. A copy is attached to this email and another will be posted on the website. Please take care to supply us with as much detail about your preferences as possible. We have published a provisional programme on the website. This programme only includes the main starting times and may be slightly revised. In short: Morning sessions will start at about 09:30, there will be tea breaks in the mornings and afternoons, and a lunch Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

- Wednesday 8 July: Keynote address and parallel sessions.
- Thursday 9 July: Keynote address and parallel sessions, **18:00-late conference dinner** (elective).
- Friday 10 July: Parallel sessions, 11:00 CASA General meeting, 12:30 Lunch, 16:00 Outing to a nearby game farm (elective) including cocktails, game drive and African style dinner.

If you haven't yet arranged accommodation you need not be overly worried. Most of the guest-houses around the venues still have available rooms. Dennekamp provides hostel style accommodation at ZAR120.00 and ZAR150.00. If you need advice regarding accommodation please contact Nadine (nadine.havenga@nwu.ac.za).

The conference will arrange transport opportunities from and back to OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg. The trips will be scheduled to accommodate as many participants as possible and will probably leave the airport at two different timeslots on the Tuesday morning.
